



**New Students: HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE REQUIREMENT**



**California State University Executive Order 622 requires that ALL F-1 students and J-1 Visa Students must** have or purchase and maintain adequate health insurance coverage during their stay in the United States. Those who come with non-F-1 & J-1 student status are strongly advised to have adequate health insurance coverage as well. You will be asked to provide proof of coverage during **the first day of registration**.

\*\*\* If you do not have health insurance coverage from your home country, you must purchase **\*\*International Student Health Insurance. \*\* You can now do this \*\* BEFORE \*\*** leaving your country:

In order to comply, your insurance policy must meet **ALL of the following criteria:**

1. The policy is valid as long as you are enrolled at ALI.
2. The medical benefits:

**\*\* ACCIDENT Medical Expenses: at least \$50,000 (\$100,000 recommended)**

**\*\* SICKNESS Medical Expenses: at least \$50,000 (\$100,000 recommended)**

3. Co-payment does not exceed 25% of bill per visit.
4. The REPATRIATION benefit is at least \$7,500.
5. The medical EVACUATION benefit is at least \$10,000.
6. The ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLE is no more than \$150.
7. The policy must pay for PRE-EXISTING conditions after 6 months of continuous coverage. (Pre-existing condition waiting periods of 6 months or less is California Law.)

\*\*\*\*\*

You are **REQUIRED** to show proof of INSURANCE coverage from your home country. The policy must cover the \* **ENTIRE TIME** \* you will study at ALI. If you do NOT have it, you will be **TERMINATED** from class (can not attend).
